The students in the Confirmation class did a lot of service hours for our parish and, in the process, discovered quite a bit about themselves and their beliefs. They painted a fence in the cemetery, visited some elderly parishioners with food baskets and small gifts, served meals in the soup kitchen, volunteered as babysitters during Sunday Mass and were servers and cantors and ushers at various times during the year.
